

A WORKSHOP / REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF ANDOVER, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY WAS HELD ON THURSDAY, APRIL 7th, 2022 AT THE BOROUGH HALL BEGINNING AT 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Morgan reported that Harold Pellow responded to the NJDOT regarding the Mid-Block Crosswalk Improvements – North Project survey with the concerns of the water line in the area. Mr. Pellow will also be submitting lower Maple Street and Smith Street for municipal aid grants.

Mr. Smith mentioned that there should be crack-sealing on the roads along Lakeview and Prospect Avenue to preserve the roadway. Some ideas were suggested such as a shared service inquiry or cooperative purchasing agreement.

The CFO reported that the annual Statewide Grant has been launched for 2022. He has been successful in receiving them in other towns and members of the Administrative Committee agreed we should submit them annually to incorporate with ongoing projects.
